

MOORING CONSENT FORM

This document gives Rodney Mooring Services (RMS) authority to inspect your mooring and if need be serviced. It also outlines our payment terms and conditions and gathers some basic information about your mooring. Once this form is submitted we will then deem this document an order to inspect your mooring against the Auckland Transports recommended standards.
